Dear Yolo County Caregiver,

Your child in care has been enrolled into the **Partnership HealthPlan of California (PHC)**, a managed care program for Solano, Napa and Yolo County **Medi-Cal recipients**.

To answer your questions, enclosed is some information for you and a letter will be provided for your child's health care providers. Always show your letter to your children medical providers.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

Medical Care: You may go to any Medi-Cal doctor that is willing to bill PHC for covered services.

Routine Eye Check-Ups and Glasses. You may go to any Medi-Cal optometrist that is willing to bill PHC for covered optometry services.

Prescriptions: PHC works with a company called MedImpact. If your foster child needs a prescription filled, you should call MedImpact at (800) 788-2949. They will give you a list of participating pharmacies near you that will fill Medi-Cal covered prescriptions.

Dental: Dental is covered by State **Denti-Cal**, NOT PHC. If you have questions about dental coverage, you should call the State **Denti-Cal office at (800) 322-6384**.

Mental Health/Counseling Services: If your foster child needs outpatient counseling/mental health services, you should call the County Department of Mental Health. For **Yolo County that number is (888) 965-6647**.

PHC covers all Medi-Cal covered services. Pre-authorization may be needed for some services, such as hospital admissions, surgery, and some prescriptions. Health care providers needing information about services requiring authorizations should call us at (800) 863-4155.

If you have questions regarding PHC or getting Medi-Cal services for your foster child, please call our Member Services Department at (800) 863-4155. We are available to help you Monday-Friday, 8:00 am to 5:00 pm.

In Yolo County call **Public Health Nurse, Judy Lehman**, PHN III, MSW at **(530) 666-8240** if needed for help in obtaining PHC services. Her office is located at the CPS Office, 170 West Beamer Street in Woodland.
